The Cowarts are prior recipients of the American Heart Association's Silver Distinguished Service Award, the Heart of Gold Award, and are proud members of the Cor Vitae Society. Their daughter Claire Cowart Haltom, who is a shareholder at Baker Donelson, in continuation of her family's commitment, formed the Pulse Board as a way for the American Heart Association to engage the next generation of philanthropic leaders.

Mr. Cowart is chair of Baker Donelson's Health Law/Government Relations & Public Policy Department and a member of the Firm's board of directors. He is a recognized authority in advising senior management regarding policy, regulatory and business issues related to health care.
