Linda Klein Honored with ABA's Muskie Pro Bono Award

Currently she is president of Southface Energy Institute and sits on the boards of Neighbor to Family and the Board of Directors Network.

Well respected in the Georgia legal community by her peers, Ms. Klein was named as one of the state's "Legal Elite" by *Georgia Trend* magazine and has been listed among *Georgia Super Lawyers* as one of the "Top 50 Women Lawyers in Georgia" annually since 2004. She is also listed in *Chambers USA* and *Best Lawyers*. In 2004, she was honored with the prestigious Margaret Brent Award. Earlier this year, she received the Randolph Thrower Lifetime Achievement Award from the State Bar of Georgia for her achievements in promoting diversity in the legal profession. In May, Ms. Klein was inducted into the YWCA's Academy of Women Achievers.
