Tom Daschle Discusses Washington Topics Affecting Health Care in the Nashville Post

A slate of expert speakers told attendees of the Nashville Health Care Council's 2015 Leadership Health Care Delegation that Washington is holding its breath as it awaits the U.S. Supreme Court's ruling in the controversial *King v. Burwell* case, which could eliminate health insurance subsidies for about eight million Americans. Mr. Daschle said that, while there are areas for bipartisan support on issues like precision medicine, telehealth and the Sustainability Growth Rate (SGR) reform, Congress remains divided on issues related to the ACA.
