Representative Matters

- Served as Tennessee counsel for an international drug manufacturer in numerous opioid cases as part of nationwide litigation. These cases, filed by state and local governments, sought to recover billions spent on the opioid crisis. Plaintiffs included the State of Tennessee, over half of its counties, numerous cities and towns, and classes including babies allegedly born addicted to opioids. The cases alleged various state law theories, including nuisance, negligence, and violations of the Tennessee Drug Dealer Liability Act and consumer protection laws. Some cases were dismissed, others settled, and the remaining were discharged in the client's bankruptcy.
- Represented an international medical device manufacturer as Tennessee counsel in a suit alleging that pedicle screws used in the plaintiff's back surgery were defective and unreasonably dangerous, which caused them to break several months after surgery and severely injure the plaintiff. The suit was dismissed with leave to amend in response to a motion to dismiss, but was never refiled.
- Represented a national consumer products manufacturer in connection with a product liability suit alleging that a defective and unreasonably dangerous sleeper caused the death of the plaintiff's infant. The case alleged various legal theories including negligence, strict liability, and failure to warn. After the parties engaged in written discovery, the plaintiff voluntarily dismissed the suit and has not refiled it.
