PREPARATION

- □ Identify key stakeholders within your organization to be part of your incident response team.
- □ Enter into a pre-negotiated retainer agreement with counsel.
- \Box Inventory key assets and data.
- Ensure backups of critical data.
- Prepare an Incident Response Plan outlining protocols for responding to an incident.
- Develop other relevant plans including crisis management communication plans and business continuity plans.

- \Box Make initial assessment with the assistance of legal counsel.
- Retain a qualified forensic investigator through counsel to investigate and evaluate the incident.
- \Box Preserve evidence related to the incident.

CONTAINMENT, ERADICATION, AND RECOVERY

- Develop a containment strategy.
- Reset passwords.
- Eradicate the threat.
- □ Implement purposeful restoration of services.
- □ Continue monitoring through endpoint detection software.

- □ In conjunction with counsel, determine notification obligations, if any.
- Assess entities that may need to be notified, including law enforcement agencies, regulatory bodies, customers/clients, media, etc.

- Evaluate lessons learned.
- □ Implement additional security controls and/or policies and procedures based on assessment of the incident.
- Regularly test your Incident Response Plan through tabletop exercises.
